Burlington School District Policy F 14: ENTRANCE AGE

Effective September 1, 1990, a child may enter kindergarten provided he/she will be five years old on or before **September 1**st of the school year during which he/she is enrolled.

Effective September 1, 2001 a child may enter first grade provided he/she will be six years old on or before **September 1**st of the school year during which he/she is enrolled.

The Superintendent or designee has the authority to grant exceptions according to written procedures.

Birth certificates or acceptable documentation are required and must be presented by all pupils entering the Burlington Public Schools for the first time.
