Greetings BSD Community,

On Sunday, March 15, Governor Scott declared that starting no later than Wednesday, March 18, all schools will be closed in Vermont through at least April 6th, if not longer.

To allow parents time to make appropriate arrangements, BSD will remain open on Monday and Tuesday. However, no student is required to be in school on Monday or Tuesday and there will be no penalties if you would prefer to keep your student out of school on those days. In fact, if you are able, I would encourage you to keep students home preemptively.

Our District Health Team will be meeting Monday morning to finalize plans in our District. Please be on the lookout for more communication following our meeting. In the meantime, there is already a lot of information available on our **coronavirus webpage**.
