Burlington School District 2020/2021 Strategic Goals		
Goal 1	Our schools are restorative and equitable communities.	<ul> <li>Schools suspend African American students, students with disabilities, and students who qualify for FRL less frequently.</li> <li>Staff report increased use of restorative practices.</li> </ul>
Goal 2	Students are <b>at grade level</b> in reading and math <b>by the end of third</b> grade.	% proficient improves for students who qualify for FRL.
Goal 3	Students are at grade level in math by the end of 8th grade.	% proficient improves for students who qualify for FRL.
Goal 4	Students graduate from high school having <b>successfully completed Algebra II</b> .	We will increase the % of students who complete Algebra II.
Goal 5	AP, Honors, and dual enrollment completion and successes <b>reflect the demographics of the high school.</b>	We will increase the % of students of color who take AP, Honors, and dual enrollment courses.
Goal 6	Faculty and staff are a <b>mirror of our student population</b> . They are highly skilled and set high expectations for all students.	Increase the % of our teaching faculty who are teachers of color.

## **BHS Updates - Downtown and Institute Rd. Campus**

#### **BHS Downtown**

- Work has begun
- Completed by Feb 22
- Move-in date first or second week of March
- \$10m over 3.5 years

#### **Institute Road Campus**

- Permission to use part of building for sports
- Testing to find full extent of PCB contamination
- Pilot Program to remediate begins in March
- Results and decision, Summer 2021





## FY '22 Budget

### **Tight Budget Year**

- 9% increase statewide
  - 13% in BSD without savings
- Identifying savings to reduce tax impact:
  - Looking for efficiencies
  - Using surplus
  - Seeking state aid for BHS Downtown
- No plans for large-scale layoffs
- Very few adds
