

If at any time you develop symptoms, you **must** stay home from school.

## I am a close contact. What do I do?

### Are Up to Date on your COVID-19 Vaccines

- \* If you develop symptoms at any time, get tested.
- \* You may access tests through your school nurse.

### Are NOT up to Date on your COVID-19

- \* Take 2 antigen tests 24 hours apart or longer. Take the first test no earlier than Day 4 (Day 0 was the last day you were around someone who tested positive)  
**OR**
- \* On or after Day 5, take a PCR or a LAMP test
- \* If you develop symptoms at anytime, get tested.

### Additional Precautions

- \* You may choose to take extra precautions such as wearing a mask.
- \* If someone you live with tests positive and you are not up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines, you may choose to get tested after their positive test and again every 2-3 days during their isolation.

### “Up to Date”

#### Up-to-Date means you:

- \* Had your booster shot **OR**
- \* Completed your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine series within the last 5 months **OR**
- \* Completed your Johnson & Johnson vaccine within the last 2 months
