





REQUEST for PRE-QUALIFICATION Re: BURLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL & TECHNICAL CENTER PROJECT Construction Manager: The Whiting-Turner Contracting Co. Burlington, Vermont

The Whiting-Turner Contracting Company (WT), the construction manager, is accepting Pre-Qualification submissions for the Burlington High School & Technical Center Project located in Burlington, VT.

The new school is approximately 250,000 SF spread out over 4 levels, and will be built on the same site as the existing high school. The footprint of the new construction overlaps the existing BHS footprint, thus requiring coordination of construction activities with owner's remediation/demolition contractors due to PCBs, asbestos and urban soils present in the existing buildings and surrounding site. The new project will require trade subcontractors for all divisions of work, and in the below table, you will see which divisions of work that require a Pre-Qualification submission. The project will kick-off in January 2023, with owner driven demolition/abatement and follow with early release packages such as structural, sitework, and roofing. Construction will begin the spring/summer of 2023. Substantial completion in 2025.

Who needs to Pre-Qualify and why?

Vermont bid law 16 V.S.A. § 559(b)(2) requires that any construction contract that exceeds \$500,000, contractors must be prequalified by the board prior to being approved to bid on the project and the school board must establish a list of prequalification criteria.

(2) At least 60 days prior to the proposed bid opening on any construction contract to be awarded by a school board that exceeds \$500,000, the school board shall publicly advertise for contractors interested in bidding on the project. The advertisement shall indicate that the school board has established prequalification criteria that a contractor must meet, and shall invite any interested contractor to apply to the school board for prequalification. All interested contractors shall submit their qualifications to the school board, which shall determine a list of eligible prospective bidders based on the previously established criteria. At least 30 days prior to the proposed bid opening, the school board shall give written notice of the board's determination to each contractor that submitted qualifications. The school board shall consider all bids submitted by prequalified bidders meeting the deadline.

Approved Pre-Qualification Criteria:

- 1. An established firm that can demonstrate a clear and stable organizationalstructure.
- 2. Hold certifications, licenses (in the state of VT) and/or registrations appropriate to the work to be performed.
- 3. Demonstrated experience or expertise with K-12 or institutional related projects
- 4. Demonstrated experience or expertise with projects of similar scope and size.
- 5. Sufficient financial capacity, including the ability to secure performance and payment bonds for contracts \$500,000 or more.
- 6. Positive references from credible and knowledgeable sources.
- 7. A construction load that will not interfere with the company's ability to perform the work in a safe, timely and adequate manner of quality.
- 8. Demonstrated ability to comply with all municipal building codes including the City of







Burlington's Women in Trades Ordinance and the City of Burlington's Livable Wage Ordinance along with all reporting and filing requirements.

- 9. Proven ability to maintain past project schedules.
- 10. Quality of workmanship.
- 11. Proven ability to maintain safe working conditions.
- 12. Proven ability to safely and efficiently work in occupied facilities.
- 13. Proven ability to close out project after reaching project substantial completion.
- 14. Proven follow-up on completed projects.
- 15. Willingness to return to correct warranted items.
