BURLINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY

CODE C3: STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Former Policy F1R

Purpose

This policy is intended to support the provision of transportation services to students to and from school based on certain criteria.

Definitions

Legal pupil has the same meaning as set forth in 16 V.S.A. §1073, as amended from time to time.

Policy

Where it is reasonable and necessary to enable a student entitled or required to attend a school within the Burlington School District, the district may furnish transportation on public roads to students who reside within the district. The district may also provide transportation to non-resident students.

Administrative Responsibilities

The superintendent shall:

- 1. File the policy in the principal's office in each school in the district
- 2. Establish bus routes and designate bus stops, taking into consideration both the safety of children and efficiency of operation, and the following factors:
 - 1) The age and health of pupils;
 - 2) Distance to be traveled;
 - 3) Condition of the road; and
 - 4) Type of highway.
- 3. The superintendent may consider any other factors deemed appropriate when establishing routes and designated stops.
- 4. Submit to the school board the total number of pupils transported by the school district and the expense thereof in the annual report to the school board.
